

- VOLUNTEERING MISSION -ENGLISH TEACHER

Taramana is a French-Cambodian NGO whose aim is to support education and improve the lives of about 200 children living in the underprivileged area of Boeing Salang, located in the north part of Phnom Penh City.

Founded in 2005, Taramana is a non-profit organization under the French law of 1901 for nonprofit organizations. In 2007, Taramana was recognized locally as an NGO within the Kingdom of Cambodia.

Taramana now welcomes over 200 disadvantaged children. The main role of the organization is to support the children's education in Boeng Salang by contributing to school fees. In addition to that, we also provide support classes in Khmer and foreign languages (English and French) as well as computer courses. In conjunction with this long-term goal, it is also essential to give the children better living conditions. This is why we ensure a complete medical follow-up and offer access to a balanced diet and extracurricular activities.

Taramana's actions are divided into four areas of activities:

- Education : Khmer, English and French classes
- Health and nutrition : vaccination, dental care, health education
- Social support : rice distribution to the families
- Arts and sports : rugby, dance, music, football etc.
